



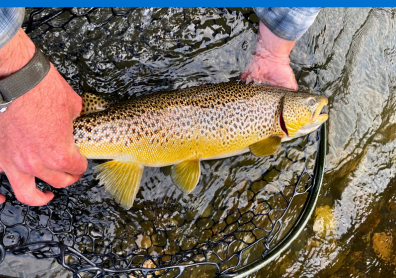
Rainbows

A rosy red stripe along lateral line to a brick red lateral band (especially in spawning males) and tints of yellow or orange along the ventral region. Gill covers can also be brilliant red.



Cutbows

A typical trout body shape, a pink or red lateral stripe like a rainbow, and both black spots and red or orange markings under the jaw.



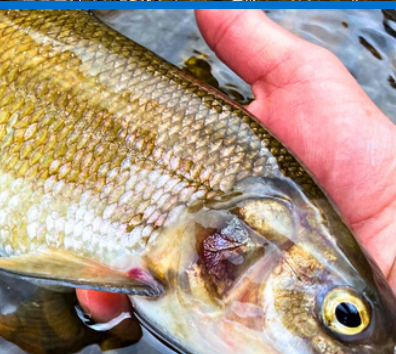
Browns

Often have a brassy appearance. Sides grade from tan to yellow. Their back and sides are marked with olive brown to black spots.



Cutthroats

Streamlined body, small, irregularly shaped dark spots. They are known for their red, pink, or orange markings beneath the jaw.



Whitefish

Silvery fish with a olive-green dorsal area and a white belly. A slender, cylindrical body shape, a small, down-turned mouth, and large scales, an adipose fin, a forked tail, and a prominent snout.



Brook Trout

A dark, olive-green back with pale, worm-like markings, sides are a bluish hue with red and yellow spots. A pale, yellowish-orange belly is common, lower fins are orange-red with a white leading edge, followed by a black streak.
